- 1. Explain the significance of photography in a literary text of your choice using theoretical concepts posited by Roland Barthes and Susan Sontag.
- 2. (a) How are history, memory, time, and timelessness mapped in Langston Hughes' 'The Negro Speaks of Rivers'?

Or

- (b) Examine Langston Hughes' poetry in the context of the Harlem Renaissance.
- 3. Comment on the lyrics and melody of *any two* songs by Bob Dylan.
- 4. (a) *Pride and Prejudice* is a 'novel of interactions'; *Bride and Prejudice* is a 'Hollywood musical which uses Bollywood elements'. Comment.

- (b) Do you think Akira Kurosawa's *Throne of Blood* is a true adaptation of William Shakespeare's *Macbeth*? Justify your answer.
- 5. What do you understand by the term 'Epic Theatre'? Discuss with references to Bertolt Brecht's play *Mother Courage*.
- 6. Describe the salient features of folk theatre. What are the changes that have affected contemporary folk theatre? Discuss with reference to *any one* performance tradition.
