(d) Ðonnemonbēam on wudaforbærne, ondweorðeyppe on þone ðe hit dyde, gielde hēfulwīte: gesellesixtigscillinga - for þam þefyrbiðþeof.

dyrnragasta.

wisramonnawongsceawian,

oþþæt he færingafyrgeþeamas
 oferharnestanhleonianfunde,
 wynleasnewudu; wæter under stod
dreorigondgedrefed.
