- 3. Show how *The Masque of Blackness* ultimately reinforces white supremacy and Eurocentrism.
- 4. Does the play A Yorkshire Tragedy challenge patriarchal assumptions or tacitly corroborate them? Discuss, with textual examples.
- 5. Is it possible to read *The Island Princess* as a celebration of colonial and patriarchal aggression? Discuss, with special attention to the titular character.
- 6. Discuss how Marlowe's Tamburlaine plays and Greene's *Selimus* try to address and contain the fear of the Islamic Other in early modern England.
