- 3. The Japanese cinema of the 1960s displays a collective obsession with the post-War subject and it's confrontations with the past through 'embodied memories'. Critically comment with special reference to the works of Nagisa Oshima and Shohei Imamura.

4. Critically compare the different motivations behind the 'reflexive' narrative effects in the radical film experimentations in France, Germany and Japan during the late 1960s with examples of your choice.
