- 1. How did Shakespeare become a tool of empire? Discuss with examples.
- 2. How does Shakespeare provide a space of modernity to the colonized subject? Illustrate your answer with suitable examples.
- 3. Critically discuss the terms interculturalism, intraculturalism and multiculturalism. How suitable are these terms to understand modes of the reception of Shakespeare in former colonies.
- 4. How do you understand the racial politics of Aime Cesaire's A Tempest? And how might you connect the explicit racialisation of the characters to the politics of decolonization?
- 5. Discuss the politics of gender in the two instances of rewriting of Shakespeare: Season of Migration to the North and A Tempest.
- 6. Discuss Shakespeare's globalisation in the international market using the phenomenon of "Bollywood Shakespeares".
- 7. Critically examine the film Shakespearewallah in the light of post colonial cultural politics.
