- 1. With reference to the evolution of English jurisprudence, provide a critical survey of the discourses on revenge circulating in Elizabethan and Jacobean England.
- 2. Comment on the deployment of physical appetite as the dominant metaphor of Seneca's *Thyestes*. How is it linked with the desire for revenge?
- 3. Is Titus Andronicus a revenger-hero or a revenger-villain? Discuss, taking into account the sources and analogues for Shakespeare's play.
- 4. How does *Richard III* both evoke and undercut the revenge ethic? What are its connections with the providential design of Tudor history?
- 5. Given its unsettling view of human corruptibility, how does *The Malcontent* qualify to be a revenge comedy rather than a revenge tragedy?
- 6. How does *The Revenger's Tragedy* approach the theme of tyranny? Discuss, with reference to the play's use of Christian emblematic traditions.
- 7. Critically comment on the nexus between sexual transgression and vengeance in 'Tis Pity She's a Whore.
