- 1. Critically discuss the salient characteristics and achievements of the Metaphysical Poets as recognized by Grierson.
- 2. How does the reappraisal of the 'Metaphysical poets' by T. S. Eliot help in depoliticizing the seventeenth century?
- 3(a) Compare and contrast the use of religious vocabulary in Donne's poem 'The Canonization' and Cleveland's poem 'Upon Phillis Walking in a Morning Before Sun-rising'.

- 3(b) Does the construction of the poet's persona in Donne's Satire V differ from that in his devotional poems? Discuss, with reference to any two devotional poems by Donne.
- 4. Critically comment on the paradox of divine sacrifice as explored in Herbert's poems 'The Altar', 'The Banquet' and 'Love (III)'.
- 5. How does Marvell use the vulnerability of argument in Metaphysical poetry for thinking about the self-divisions and self-destructiveness of his times?
- 6. Do you agree that Crashaw espouses an aesthetic of excess? Discuss, with close reference to his poem 'The Weeper'.
- 7. Does Vaughan's evocation of Nature simultaneously deploy and challenge mainstream Christian belief? Discuss, with reference to any two of his poems.
