- 3. (a) Some critics think that Shelley's transition from atheism to pantheism was a direct result of William Jones's writings inspired by India. Do you agree? Justify your answer with reference to 'Hymn to Intellectual Beauty', 'Alastor', *Queen Mab* and *Prometheus Unbound*.

(b) Rabindranath does not seek merely salvation of the individual but like Shelley also cherishes the ideal of the collective happiness and freedom of the human race. Do you agree? Answer with reference to his poems especially his translations of Shelley's verses.
