- 3. (a) Can alienation be deployed both as form and theme as a critique of mimesis? Comment critically on the possibilities of alienation with reference to the Brechtian political strategy of alienation and Strindberg's formula of meaninglessness.

Comment critically, with close reference to *Miss Julie, The Caucasian Chalk Circle* and *Rhinoceros*.
