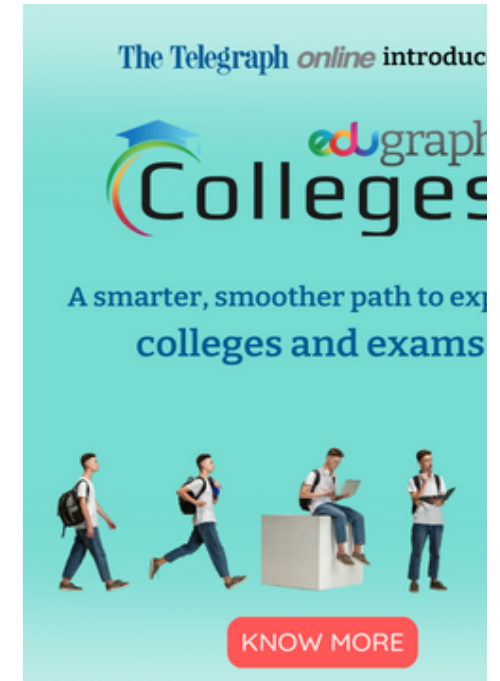
Over the three days the participating students understood how to keep their personal opinions and notions aside when they are representing a country.
