- 1. In what ways could Alexandre Astruc's essay 'La Camera Stylo' have influenced the film aesthetics and practice of the Nouvelle Vague generation? Answer with specific references to the work of Jean-Luc Godard and Eric Rohmer.
- 2. The aesthetics of early French New Wave cinema was predicated upon ludic yet critical forms of cinematic self-awareness. Comment with relevant examples.
- 3. Japanese New Wave cinema in the 1960s gained a thematic consistency through critical representations of 'vulnerable bodies and morals'. Critically comment using examples.
- 4. East European new cinemas often used strategies to represent a past grounded in the historical experiences of erstwhile political regimes. Discuss with examples.
