- 1. If "Visual Pleasure and Narrative Cinema" challenged conventional notions of spectatorial habits, Laura Mulvey reconfigured viewing pleasure within the same conventions in the 'Afterthoughts' to the essay. Discuss.
- 2. Queer theory makes a critical intervention that earlier conceptualisation of gender and sexuality in cinema could not achieve. Discuss.
- 3. "The images of the neurotic man or woman .. become the visions of the director... Is this the reason why modern cinema has such need for neurotic characters: to sustain the free indirect discourse...?" Examine this observation by Gilles Deleuze in *Cinema 1*.
- 4. Deleuze writes that in post-war American cinema "the image no longer refers to a situation which is globalising or synthetic, but to one which is dispersive." What does it mean for the emergence of a cinema beyond the rationality of the 'action-image'?
