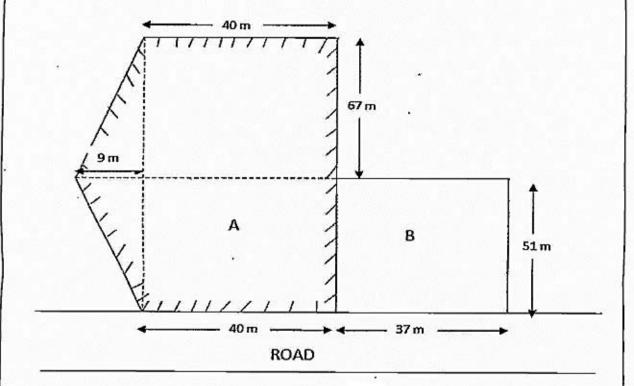

He now desires to sell the same and has received an offer of Rs 42 lakhs with vacant possession or in the alternative, he has been offered a monthly rent of Rs 30000 for his building and open plot together. Advise the owner whether he should sell the property or give it on a rental basis given the following:
- i) Value of land in the neighborhood for similar plots: Rs 2000/sq.m.
- ii) Sinking fund rate= 4%
- iii) Total out goings = 45% of gross rent
- iv) Present cost of construction of such a bungalow =Rs 1800/mtr.cu.
