JU unable to implement own statutes, says HC, seeks plan to tackle ragging menace

The Calcutta high court on Monday questioned Jadavpur University's inability to implement its own statutes governing student and hostel affairs, and said the matter needed to be discussed with all stakeholders, including students, report Subrata Chattoraj & Rohit Khanna. The court also directed the university to submit a compilation of the Jadavpur University Act, 1981, the regulations and rules related to student welfare and admission in hostels, along with a plan on ways to deal with the ragging menace, during the next hearing after two weeks.

The bench said that the students needed to be heard before passing any order.
