2. (a) The *Valmīki Rāmāyaṇa* foregrounds human aspirations in constant dialogue with divine machinations. Do you agree? Discuss with suitable textual examples.

- (b) Would you agree that the Itihasa-Purana acted as the 'inherited text' for the later Puranas? Discuss with reference to the *Mahābhārata* and the *Srimād Bhāgvat Mahāpurana*.
- 3. (a) Comment critically on the role of nature and landscape in the *Dhammapada* and the Sangam poetry with close reference to the texts.

(b) Through its preoccupation with the basic human desire for love and personal glory, Sangam poetry highlights certain social and moral codes of conduct that are emblematic of the ethical worldview of the ancient Tarmil-speaking community. Discuss with close reference to the text.
