- 5. What marks of distinction do you think the "Cavalier" poets demonstrate in their writing? Discuss with reference to the poems that you have studied.
- 6. "Milton's argument for the legitimacy of regicide is founded on his account of the origin of the state." Discuss with reference to *The Tenure of Kings and Magistrates*.
- 7. How is the character of Cromwell assessed in the "Horatian Ode"? Discuss.
- 8. A. "'Upon Appleton House' utterly transforms the form and content of the 17<sup>th</sup> century country-house poem." Do you agree? Discuss.
