- a. The serpent and the eagle
- b. 'My soul is an enchanted boat.'
- c. Prometheus's curse.
- d. 'This is the winter of the world, and here, we die.'
- 2. Discuss the significance of the muteness of the Child of Light in *The Revolt*. Why do you think the Tyrant keeps her around?
- 3. 'Each from the other sought/Refuge in solitude.' What happens just before this? Discuss Shelley's ideas of adolescence and personality in the light of these facts.
- 4. Compare Cythna's undersea cave with Mab's space station as gateways to enlightenment.
- 5. 'The burning of the atheist in *Queen Mab*, the ultimate fates of Laon and Cythna, and the millennial suffering of Prometheus: these are all good things in the eyes of conventional morality.' Discuss,
- 6. Why do you think Demogorgon first appears as an oracle? Is he a satisfactory oracle? Give reasons.
- 7. Examine the nature and significance of Jove's surprise on seeing Demogorgon alight from the Car of the Hour.
- 8. 'Even love is sold.' Evaluate Shelley's critique of patriarchy on the basis of the poems you have read.
- 9. 'Laon makes two major errors of judgement in *The Revolt of Islam*: one at the beginning of his revolutionary career, and one at the end, and in both cases Cythna suffers for them.' Discuss Laon's character in the light of this statement.
