- 1. (a) Discuss the scope & definition of the term "Retrenchment of workers" in the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947
 - (b) State giving reasons whether the following are industries under Industrial Disputes Act, 1947:
 - (i) An University.
 - (ii) A group of hospitals run by a State Government for giving Medical relief to citizens & imparting Medical Education.
 - (iii) Calcutta Club or any other club incorporated as a Company under the Companies Act of the respective country.
 - (iv) An Unani College of Pharmacy manufacturing medicines for sale &for the benefit of students of the college besides other activities.
- 2. (a) Discuss the exceptions to the employer's liability in compensating a workman from a personal injury caused to him by an accident arising out & in course of employment?
 - (b) Mr. 'P' a workman, in willful disobedience of an order impliedly given to him by his employer, meets a serious accident resulting him a major injury. Assess how far the employer is liable to pay compensation? What will happen in case the workman dies as a result of the same accident?  - (b) Mr. 'LPG' an employee of a big chain of departmental shops was NOT paid his wage for three months. Can he claim his wages under the *Payment of Wages Act*, 1936?
 - (c) Discuss briefly the maximum wage-period prescribed under the Payment of Wages Act, 1936.
