- 2. 'He prayeth best, who loveth best.' How do you think the Ancient Mariner teaches the Wedding Guest to love better? Give reasons for your answer.
- 3. Discuss the Englishness of the Lucy poems.
- 4. If we could really hold the 'Great Assembly' described at the end of the *Masque of Anarchy*, what do you think would be discussed there? Explain your answer.
- 5. 'Art cannot feel yet it is full of feeling'. Comment on this paradox with respect to the 'Ode on a Grecian Urn'.
- 6. With reference to any two prose writers of the day, describe one big issue that polarised the views of intellectuals of the time.
- 7. 'With the "Sonnets from the Portuguese", for the first time we have the story of a great romance told from the woman's point of view.' Discuss.
- 8. Robert Browning in 'The Pied Piper of Hamelin' makes his protagonist a moral guardian against the greed and corruption of capitalist society. How relevant do you think this message is for the nineteenth century? Give reasons.
- 9. 'The message of the "Lotos Eaters" is the same as that of the *Masque of Anarchy*, only couched in more personal terms, and without the direct challenge to authority.' Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer.
