Blind girl's death: JU bars two from campus

Kolkata: Jadavpur University on Wednesday decided that the internal complaints committee (ICC) would probe the circumstances leading to the death of Renaisa Das, a blind second-year English student. It was also decided at the meeting, which was attended by HoDs, deans and officials, that the accused would be barred from the campus till the end of the probe.

"The human rights commission has sought a report. We will reply within the time given. The ICC will probe the case and submit a report in a month," said an official. The debarment letter, signed by registrar Snehamanju Das, read: "...you are hereby debarred from entering the campus of Jadavpur University till the enquiry is completed..." Renaisa had died by suicide at her Malbazar home on Jan 18 and her parents lodged a complaint at JU on Thursday, accusing a student and a research scholar, both blind, of provoking her to take the step. An FIR was also lodged at the Malbazar PS.

Sources said Renaisa, who earlier used to stay at the hos tel, was staying at home for the past few months. She came to the hostel on Jan 1 and returned home after the semester

English HoD Manojit Mandal said, "Dean of arts Shibashis Chatterjee and two professors, Ishan Chakraborty and Paramita Chakravarti, will assist the ICC team." Sources said it was found necessary to include Chakraborty, who is also visually impaired.

A member of the Forum for Students with Disabilities Subhadip Mondal said, "Officials said a preliminary report will be given by February 12 and the probe will be over in a month. They also accepted our demand of barring the accused till the end of the probe."

The accused blind student, who stays at hostel, said, "The decision will affect my studies. I have my internals from Feb 2 and semester exams after that. The allegations are not yet proved." The research scholar said he would cooperate with the probe.
