- 1. With reference to the works of Socrates and Lucretius, critically examine the role of philosophy as therapy for the fear of death.
- 2. Compare the ways in which corpses are depicted in the cultural texts of the Homeric world with those of medieval/early modern Europe (with reference to texts discussed in class).
- 3. With reference to Celan and Levi, discuss the effect of the Holocaust on the possibilities of language.
- 4. Can we compare Dr. Rieux to Kierkegaard's 'knight of infinite resignation'? Give reasons for your answer. Can you identify one other protagonist/narrator from the texts discussed in class who merits this comparison?
- 5. In what ways does Keats's nightingale foreshadow the creatures who glimpse 'the open' in the Rilke's Eighth Duino Elegy? Critically compare the two poems along these lines.
- 6. "The undead in *Dracula* is a parody of resurrection theology"—Discuss.
- 7. "This baroque idea glimmers behind *Biathanatos*. The idea of a god who creates the universe in order to create his own gallows."—Borges. Discuss with reference to Donne's *Biathanatos* (and, if you wish, any other work by him).
