- 2 (a) Trace the changes in Bangla poetry in the hands of Anglicised and urbanised *Bhadralok* poets during the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

- 2(b) Make a critical evaluation of the poetry of Iswar Gupta.
- 3 (a) Would it be legitimate to see Bankimchandra as the creator of a conservative modernity while Dinabandhu Mitra represented a more radical trend? Examine their writings studied in class for your answer.

3(b) Examine the nature of gender coding that Bankimchandra Chattopadhyay wants to enforce in *The Poison Tree*.
