


Different types of standard packaging wooden boxes




Style 1: Uncleated ends, can hold upto 60lbs.




Style 2: Four cleats, 2 horizontal cleats increases rigidity of the top and bottom while 2 vertical cleats increases rigidity of box sides. Can carry upto 600lbs.




Style 2 $\frac{1}{2}$: Same as 2 but the cleat joining are different



Style 4: Two cleats, vertically or horizontally, may be inside opr outside. Can carry upto 600 lbs.





Style 5: Reduced size, internal supports of woods and carry upto 200lbs.

Style 6: Locked corners and dovetails are secured by glue between series of tensions. Can carry upto 100lbs.
