- 3. Distinguish between the 'sublime' and the 'beautiful' as postulated by Kant in his third *Critique*. Does art have any bearing upon morality or vice-versa according to this work?
- 4. Do you think Lessing rates poetry higher than the plastic/visual arts in *Laocoon*? Give reasons for your answer.
- 5. How does Aristotle turn Plato's critique of imitative literature—specifically tragedy— on its head through his re-description of 'mimesis' and 'catharsis'?
- 6. Discuss the significance of 'nature' in Schiller's new classification of poetry into 'naive' and 'sentimental'?
- 7. Discuss the significance of 'invention' in Castelvetro's conception of poetic excellence.
