- 2. Do you think reading Tagore in the original (Bengali) in a course like this makes our engagement with him culturally more significant than reading him in English translations? Give reasons for your answer.
- **3.** With reference to any two of the short stories in your syllabus, analyze how Tagore narrates an idea of India against the aggressive colonial expansion in his motherland.
- **4.** How does "Imperialism" expose the cultural politics of the British Empire in India? Discuss with examples from the essay of the same name by Tagore.

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- 5. "In most of his essays written between 1890 and 1910, Tagore was deeply engaged with contemporary nationalist politics in India." Discuss with reference to any two essays in your syllabus.
- **6.** "An act of imagination for Tagore was a conscious attempt to deny and disregard colonial reality." Discuss with reference to the poems in your syllabus.
- 7. "In most of his short stories Tagore ventured to reclaim a pre-colonial culture and geography." Discuss with reference to any two short stories that you have read.
- **8.** Do you think *Gora* is a novel that deals with an incomplete vision of contemporary India? Give reasons for your answer.
- **9.** Critically comment on Tagore's treatment of the idea of kingship in his play *Raja*.
