- Q2. Define with examples and sketches the following urban design techniques a) Physical Design Technique; b) Open Space Technique; and c) Individual Building Technique.
- Q3. Write a note on 'Urban Renewal' in global context, as well as in Indian context. Discuss the methodology of urban renewal programme in a city.
- Q4. Mention the universal principles for designing urban waterfront in a city citing suitable examples and sketches. Discuss with sketches the quality of seam at the riverfront edge of Varanasi.
- Q5. Modern urban design techniques include the 'Multi-level Uses' of urban spaces in cities. Write a note on this technique and give three best-practiced examples. Write a note on 'Sustainable Development'.
- Q6. How do you define a 'Heritage District' and 'Heritage Precinct' in a city? Why do we need to conserve historic precincts, buildings and districts in a city? How can you argue that 'Urban Conservation' is a type of 'Sustainable Development'?
