



Anti-ragging poster designed by former student put up in JU

Jadavpur University has installed an anti-ragging advertisement - "Go Green" - to stop ragging on the campus yesterday.

A theme based concept to prevent ragging has been taken up since 2007. This year, the campaign showcased small plants which are in growing stage and captioned as "Nature life say no to ragging".

The theme has been conceptualised by Parag Sarkar, a former student of mass communication, Jadavpur

University. According to the designer, "The plants are in red and the colour depicts the colour of life and strength. It is placed on conical flask where it is shown on a growing stage."

The posters and hoardings have been placed in different parts of the main campus and every department of the second campus at Salt Lake.

Along with the release of the poster, JU disclosed the list of the members of the anti-ragging squad for the current academic year where they have included six students from various departments along with professors.
